Re: 2026 AND 2027 SASKPOWER RATE REVIEW PANEL SUBMISSION

Dear Sir or Madame:

Mosaic appreciates the opportunity to provide comment on SaskPower's 2026 and 2027 rate application. As a major industrial customer and consumer of electricity, we recognize and appreciate the ongoing engagement with Crown Corporations and government on this topic.

Mosaic's position on Saskatchewan's future power plan has been consistent and clear: we must have access to affordable and reliable baseload power to produce potash the world depends on.

We are a major consumer of electricity. Our company operates three mine sites in the province which run 24 hours a day, 365 days of the year. These facilities rely on the power grid to maintain consistent operations, and our power requirements will only continue to grow as we look to increase production.

We appreciate that there has not been a rate increase since April 2023 while also acknowledging the need to ensure SaskPower's finances remain sustainable as a major utility. We recognize the importance of ensuring SaskPower has the means and ability to make necessary capital investments and improvements to ensure the power grid remains strong and reliable for customers and industry. We support SaskPower's commitment to investing in system reliability to ensure the province continues meeting its electricity needs.

Mosaic also appreciates the ongoing dialogue between the provincial and federal governments on the future of the industrial carbon tax, while continuing to provide relief from it for over a year. Mosaic's scope 2 emissions for power and electricity constitute the majority of our total carbon tax payments. We continue to advocate for competitive and fair solutions here.

We trust that those crafting the province's future power plan are best positioned to decide how we meet the shared objectives of affordable and reliable power in Saskatchewan. Mosaic looks forward to continued engagement with SaskPower and the government on the future of electricity for the benefit of mining and industry.
